The semi-final round of auditions will be held on Monday, November 2, 1992 at Powell Symphony Hall. The semi-final round of auditions will be held on stage behind a screen. The Audition Committee, without Maestro Slatkin, will be in attendance. Applicants will again be introduced by randomly selected numbers. It has been the practice of the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra to advance members of the Symphony directly into the semi-final round.

The final round of auditions will be held on Monday, November 2, following the semi-final round. The final round will be held on the open stage, with applicants introduced by name. The entire Audition Committee, including Maestro Slatkin, will be in attendance for the final round of auditions. Only finalists will be reimbursed their domestic (mainland U.S.A., closest port of entry) roundtrip transportation to St. Louis for the November 2 audition date. We do not limit the number of finalists.

Should the Principal position be offered to a member of the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra bass section, then that vacated position may be offered to the next qualified candidate.
